## SCHOOL SUPPLIES

When entering any classroom, students should have black/blue pens, red pens, pencils, yellow highlighters, and notebook paper. In addition, students should consult the following list to see what extra supplies are required for their specific classes.

English	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Folder</li> <li>• Highlighters: yellow, pink, green, and blue</li> <li>• 3-ring binder with subject dividers (at least 5 dividers)</li> <li>• Two composition notebooks (second notebook is for journal entries only; students may select that notebook based on their preference)</li> </ul>
Government/ Economics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1.5-2 inch 3 ring binder</li> <li>• Tab dividers (8)</li> </ul>
Senior Seminar/ Ethics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Binder or folder</li> <li>• Flash drive</li> <li>• Journal (any kind of notebook or journal that they prefer).</li> </ul>
Math	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Graphing Calculator (TI-84 or TI-Nspire)</li> <li>• 1 binder</li> <li>• Spiral notebooks or loose-leaf paper (a lot)</li> <li>• ∞ Pencils (mechanical preferred)</li> <li>• Colored pens</li> <li>• 1 Eraser (large)</li> <li>• Your brain</li> <li>• 1 cat</li> </ul>
AP Chemistry	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Three Ring Binder (2 inches)</li> <li>• Scientific Calculator (can be graphing or non-graphing)</li> <li>• Composition Notebook</li> </ul>
AP Psychology	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Binder or folder</li> <li>• 12 or 24 pack of <u>pre-sharpened</u> colored pencils</li> <li>• Lots of white index cards</li> <li>• Notebook/journal (student preference).</li> </ul>
Art History	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 3-hole, 3-subject spiral notebook</li> <li>• Colored pens or pencils or markers</li> </ul>
